



 NFPT – Field Day (October 24) in East Grand Forks

#### What Makes PRAC Work?

- 1. Focus ... SCRI has the best odds for potato funding
- 2. Focus ... PRAC endorses only 2-3 projects for SCRI funding
- 3. Focus ... PRAC sets "priorities" (pillars)
- 4. Elbow grease ... each project gets 50+ letters of support
- 5. Outreach ... proposals are better with a strong commitment to grower outreach






# How do Michigan Growers and MSU Fit Into PRAC Efforts
