Applicants must be enrolled as a full-time student at a post-secondary educational institution during the Spring 2026 semester in order to be eligible. All applications must be received by the Michigan Potato Industry Commission office no later than 4:30 p.m. Wednesday, January 7, 2026.

Scholarship requirements are:

- Is enrolled in a minimum of 12 credits per semester with a major related to agriculture at a Michigan accredited institution.
- Maintains a satisfactory grade point average (3.0) or better (transcript required)
- Provides a Personal Essay: educational and career goals
- Provides two (2) letters of recommendation with the application

The scholarship check will be sent to the address provided on the application, and made out to the student.
